7. COVID 19 Regulations

Fully vaccinated foreign nationals

They must present proof of vaccination by means of a certificate issued by the health authority of their country of origin, they must have health coverage in Uruguay, and they must complete the electronic form (https://declaracionjurada.ingresoauruguay.gub.uy) within 48 (forty-eight) hours prior to boarding. The Declaration must be made with the same document with which Uruguay is to be entered.

Foreign nationals who have already completed the COVID-19 disease within the last 90 (ninety) days before embarkation or arrival in the country

They must present the positive result of the PCR-RT test or antigen detection test, carried out between a maximum of 90 (ninety) days and up to 10 (ten) days before embarkation or arrival in the country. It must be attached to the Affidavit and presented to the company in which they are traveling before boarding.

In addition, they must have health coverage in Uruguay and must complete the electronic form (https://declaracionjurada.ingresoauruguay.gub.uy/) within 48 (forty-eight) hours prior to boarding. The Declaration must be made with the same document with which Uruguay is to be entered.

Unvaccinated foreign citizens

They must present a negative result of the SARS-CoV-2 virus test (PCR-RT or antigen test), performed no more than 72 (seventy-two) hours before the start of the trip. In addition, they must have health coverage in Uruguay and complete the electronic form (https://declaracionjurada.ingresoauruguay.gub.uy/) within 48 (forty-eight) hours prior to boarding. The Declaration must be made with the same document with which Uruguay is to be entered.

The voltage used in Uruguay is 220V and the electrical frequency is 50Hz.



10. Currency

The official currency of Uruguay is the Uruguayan Peso (UYU).
