## Guidance from the SAC

The SAC recommends that nominees and appointments follow the high standards of science excellence and profiles followed over the last two decades by the CoP.

Specifically, new appointments should:

- Have high academic and research excellence
- Have an established, extensive research and publication record.
- Have a Doctorate or equivalent experience.
- Be multidisciplinary, open, collegial, and demonstrate a willingness to work with other disciplines.
- Have extensive experience directing and managing international scientific projects relevant to the strategic areas of the IAI
- Understand the social, economic, and ecological realities of the Americas
- Understand the science policies and priorities of different countries

- Understand the role of and relationships between policy-maker, resource managers, social scientists, and natural scientists

Areas of expertise needed in the SAC:

- Climate Change
- Biodiversity-Ecological Diversity and Ecosystem Valuation

The SAC welcomes under-represented groups to be nominated.
