The IAI Directorate seeks a consultant team to develop training materials on science diplomacy related to global environmental change (GEC) in the Americas. These training materials should aim to enhance the capacity of professionals across the Americas to better understand science diplomacy processes and to contribute to the development of more effective public policies.

Key experts on the consulting team should have the following expertise:

- At least 7 years of professional experience with GEC science-policy in the Americas
- At least 5 years of experience developing and conducting training or related work on Science Diplomacy
- At least 3 years of experience developing and implementing curriculum and other training in a virtual learning environment.
- Knowledge of transdisciplinary research and approaches, preferably on GEC
- Experience working in or with Latin America and the Caribbean
- Fluency in English and Spanish, written and verbal

## The IAI Directorate notes that the lead organization submitting the proposal must be from an IAI member country.
