## Subject: IAI Participation in the UNFCCC Conference of the Parties (COP28) 2023

Dear Madam / Dear Sir,

The Conference of the Parties, at its 31st meeting, adopted Decision XXXI/7, which states:

XXXI/7: The Conference of the Parties instructs the IAI Directorate to engage with IAI Parties during international multilateral science-policy convenings, such as the meetings of the Conference of the Parties of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change... among others, and to seek external financial resources to sponsor an IAI delegation comprised of senior and early career scientists to disseminate relevant research with a global community, to strengthen engagement with decision-makers, to increase the visibility and participation of scientists from the region, and to increase the capacity of the region to participate in international negotiations.

In support of the above, the IAI Directorate is pleased to announce the participation of the members of the Directorate and the IAI's Science Advisory Committee and Science Policy Advisory Committee at the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) Conference of the Parties (COP28). An information document about the IAI delegation is available. COP28 will occur in Dubai, United Arab Emirates, from 30 November to 12 December 2023. The IAI is an official observer organization of the UNFCCC.
