Subject: Launching of two new courses of the IAI

I am pleased to inform you that the IAI has launched two new free, self-managed courses with certificates, aimed at researchers and practitioners from both the private and public sectors.

"Science diplomacy and global environmental change in the Americas" examines four themes: 1) science diplomacy, 2) innovation diplomacy from a Global South perspective, 3) negotiation applied to sustainable development, and science diplomacy in the face of global environmental change. The course, featuring 17 case studies aligned to the Sustainable Development Goals, is available in Spanish, Portuguese, and English.

"Advances in Transdisciplinary Research on Global Environmental Change in Latin America and the Caribbean" focuses on projects implemented in Peru, Brazil, Bolivia, Panama, Jamaica, Mexico, Uruguay, and Colombia. It explores four topics: 1) fundamental concepts of transdisciplinary research; 2) lessons from Latin America and the Caribbean; 3) capacity building for successful transdisciplinary research collaborations; 4) project design and management for equitable and ethical transdisciplinary practice. The course is available in English and Spanish.
