I am an Assistant Research in the CONICET and the Instituto de Ecologia Regional (IER) at the Universidad Nacional de Tucuman. I am an ecologist and I have used satellite images, demographic analyses and dynamics models to understand land-use change in subtropical forest of Argentina and its socioeconomic causes. My current research focuses on conservation planning of Argentine High Andean wetlands considering the most pressing threats expected for the coming decades for the region: climate change, mining and grazing. In combination with spatially explicit model of the main threats and stakeholders' workshop I shall develop consensual geographic guidelines for conservation planning. In addition, I work in promote the multidisciplinary teamwork and interdisciplinary collaboration to address conservation issues.
