
EUROPEAN COMMISSION PRIZE PROJECT: A CONSORTIUM TO EFFECTIVELY RESPOND TO CLIMATE-ATTRIBUTABLE RISKS: MALARIA ELIMINATION (ACERCARM-ME) EARLY WARNING SYSTEM

Goal: to eliminate malaria in LA using an early warning system with earth observation technology that was validated in Peru with 12-week forecast accuracy exceeding 90%. In addition to forecasting methodology, we will discuss an innovative strategy to upscale MEWS across all malaria endemic countries of LA.

STePs to upscale and implement a regional malaria early warning system in Latin America: With the IAI, the proposed societal implementation and adoption strategy of *ACERCAR-ME* employs a science diplomacy approach that aims to establish a regional network of diverse stakeholders capable of responding to malaria and other complex climate-attributable risks. 


IAI is a regional partner in curriculum development and train the trainers implementation in LAC. Project goals are:




