3. Travel and transportation

The main airport in the city of Brasilia is Presidente Juscelino Kubitschek International Airport, for local and international flights. <https://www.bsb.aero.br/>

For security and reliability, we recommend using taxis from the airport (in front of the landing doors). The taxi fare from the airport to the hotels area in Brasilia is R\$ 60.00 (approximately USD 15.00). **Uber and Cabify** are also available for transportation to Brasilia, but the cars will pick you upstairs, in front of check in counters.

Other main of transportation from de airport is the executive bus. It leaves the airport each 35 minutes between 6:30 A.M. and 11:55 P.M. and reaches the hotels area. It will cost over R\$ 12.00 per person (USD 3.00).

Estimated travel time is 30 minutes by car or 1h10 by bus, depending on the traffic.

8. Electricity

Voltage in Brazil is 220 V, with a frequency of 60 Hz.

The type N socket and plug are the official standard in Brazil. Type C plugs are also official, but not type C sockets. This does not pose a problem, however, since type C plugs are 100% compatible with type N sockets.

Official currency in Brasilia is Real (R\$) (Reais, in plural).

Dollars are not accepted in Brazil.

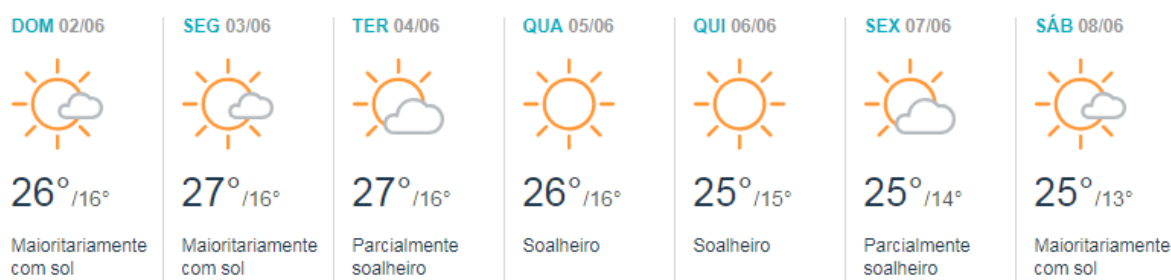
10. Medical service

Participants must cover their medical expenses. It is recommended that they take out travel health insurance.

11. Weather

The average temperature in Brasilia in June is somewhat warm at 19.1 °C (66.38 °F). Afternoons can be fairly hot with average high temperatures reaching 25.2 °C (77.4 °F). Overnight

temperatures are generally mild with an average low of 13.3 °C (55.9 °F). The range/ variation of diurnal mean temperatures in June is 11.9 °C (21.4 °F). The weather in June is arid, the average precipitation is only 8.8mm (0.3in). The average length of day is 11:11 hours.



12. Touristic information

If you wish to enjoy the city, we suggest that you visit <http://www.turismo.df.gov.br/guiaturistico/>, so you can download a guide, available in Spanish and English, where you will find tourist information about Brasília.

A city tour can be done on a special bus. You can take it daily in front of Brasília Shopping at 10:30 AM, 2 PM or 4:30 PM. During 2 hours, you may see the main Brasília touristic points.
