I am pleased to inform you that the IAI Directorate and the Past Global Changes (PAGES) Project have signed a Letter of Agreement to strengthen cooperation between the two organizations for the development of the “International mobility research Fellowship Program for Latin American and Caribbean early career scientists on past global changes”. The signing of the Agreement occurred on 21 April 2021.

The Letter of Agreement will facilitate the development and implementation of joint activities related to scientific research and capacity building in Latin America and the Caribbean countries. PAGES is an international project and scientific association which aims to improve our understanding of past changes in the Earth system to inform decision-making for sustainability.
