Edwin Castellanos is the director of the Centro de Estudios Ambientales y de Biodiversidad and the director of the GIS and Remote Sensing Laboratory at Universidad del Valle de Guatemala. He has done research for the past 15 years on the topics of mitigation (carbon sequestration in terrestrial ecosystems) and adaptation (with small farmers and rural communities) to climate change. He has been a consultant to UNDP and the Guatemalan government on climate change issues and has been part of the official Guatemalan delegation for the last four COP meetings. He is the principal investigator in a CRN project studying the adaptation strategies of small coffee growers in the Mesoamerican region. He is also a lead author of the IPCC working group II (vulnerability and adaptation) for the fifth assessment report.
