Dr. Halvorsen is a professor of Natural Resource Policy at Michigan Technological University in Michigan, USA. She holds a joint appointment to the School of Forest Resources and Environmental Science and the Department of Social Sciences Environmental and Energy Policy graduate program. Her research focuses on climate change mitigation and adaptation through the study of human relationships to environment. She currently studies the socioecological dimensions of bioenergy policy and development across the Americas and water policy decision making in the the USA and Mexico in the face of climate change. Dr. Halvorsen has worked in interdisciplinary teams of social, natural, and engineering scientists for more than twenty years. She now teaches about and researches the development of successful interdisciplinary science teamwork to study and help solve a variety of difficult environmental problems. She leads a group of 45 scientists from Brazil, Mexico, Canada, Argentina, Uruguay, and the United States studying the socioecological impacts of bioenergy development across the Americas.
