

institution for fisheries and cover almost all areas of the high seas \rightarrow However overfishing is still a serious problem


What are the SDGs and the Paris Agreement?

- \rightarrow The Sustainable Development Goals seek sustainable development in social, economic and ecological sectors.
- \rightarrow 17 goals supported by 169 targets.
- \rightarrow SDG 14 calls for conservation and sustainable use of the oceans, seas and marine resources.
- \rightarrow The Paris Agreement for climate change has the goal to reduce Green House Gas emission.
- \rightarrow It aims to stabilise temperature increase at less then 2° Celsius.



Multiple, qualitative method approach





Outcomes from this research:

- \rightarrow Improve our understanding regarding the connection between RFMOs and SDGs and the Paris Agreement.
- \rightarrow Increase awareness of the SDGs and the Paris Agreement in fisheries management organizations.
