

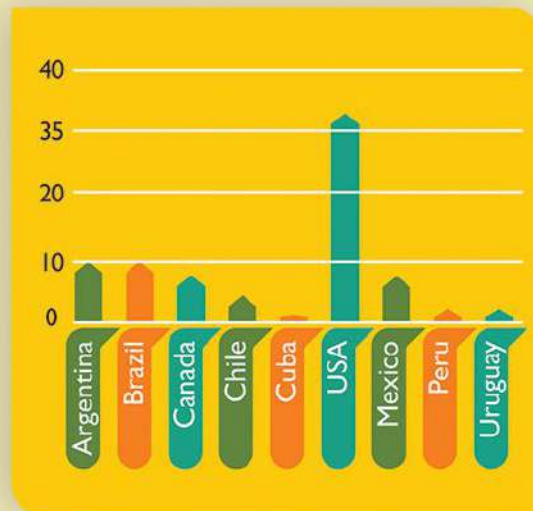

The representatives of **16 nations of the Americas** met in Montevideo, Uruguay, between **May 12 and 14, 1992** to **sign the Agreement** to create the Inter-American Institute for Global Change Research (**IAI**).

Between 1992 and 2002, 74 research projects from 9 countries received support from the IAI.



In this decade, the IAI's science program supported 53 institutions.



Between 1992 and 2002 the scientific research budget exceeded US\$ 5 million.

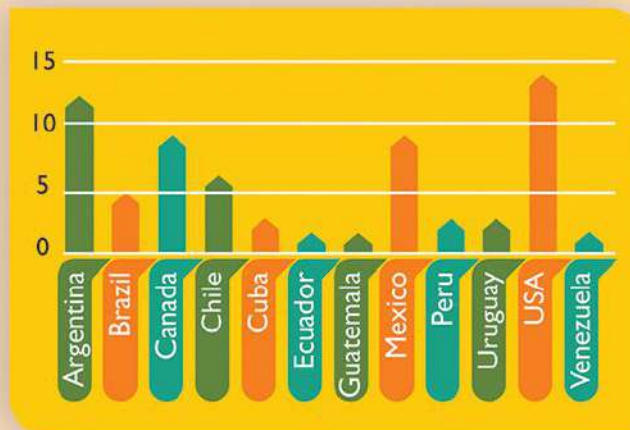

The first two rounds of the **Small Grants Program supported 38 projects** to organize collaborative networks towards developing broad scientific programs of regional relevance. The Small Grants Program focusing on Human Dimensions supported **8 programs in 12 member countries of the IAI** for the integration of the natural and social sciences with an emphasis on the implications for public policy.

Between 2002 and 2012, 70 projects in 12 countries received support.

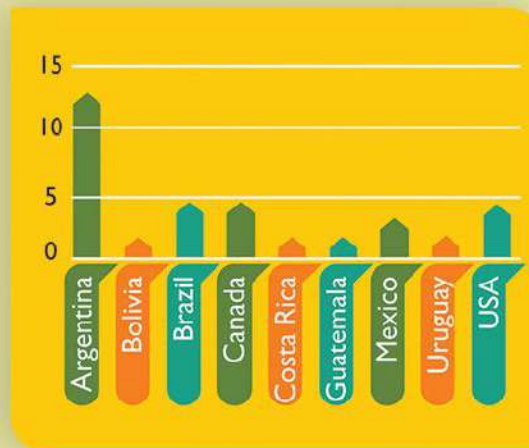

The **CRN3** call for funding was pioneering in the region: 17 transdisciplinary research networks with 112 researchers from 90 institutions in 15 member countries of the IAI were financed to focus on the social context of global change to generate relevant information for decision making. **239 student scholarships** were awarded through these projects, which **produced more than 450 publications**.

Between 2012 and 2022, 31 research projects in 9 countries received support



In this decade, the IAI's science program supported 110 institutions.

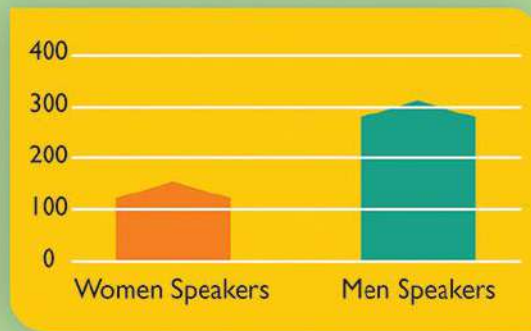
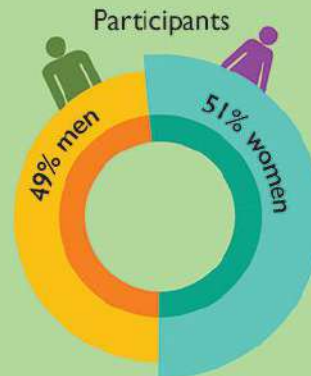


Between 2012 and 2022 the budget for scientific research exceeded US\$ 11 million

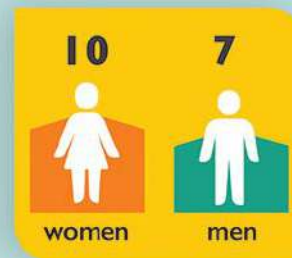

WHAT IS THE STeP FELLOWS PROGRAM?

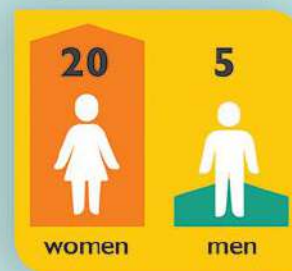
It is an innovative program of the IAI with the goal of improving human and institutional capacities in IAI member countries.
